# LIVING ROOM

The living room is typically the first room potential buyers walk into. Start by decluttering and depersonalizing. Straighten pillows, remove excess rugs and furniture, tidy up cables, dust the mantle and fireplace.

# KITCHEN

## ALL ROOMS IN HOME
