Hendersonville

Hendersonville is the second largest city in the Asheville Region. Hendersonville has a population of about 15,000. The cost of living in Hendersonville is 28.6% lower than national average. The city center has over 100 shops, 25 restaurants, and hosts many festivals throughout the year including the Apple Festival which brings over 50,000 people to the town.

Waynesville

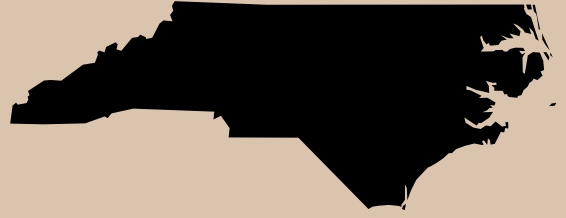
Waynesville lies in the heart of the Smoky Mountains. With a population right under 11,000 this mountain towns cost of living is 6% lower than the national average with median home prices at \$365,000. This town is very close to popular hiking spots, the Great Smoky National Park, and the Blue Ridge Parkway.

Black Mountain is located only 15 miles East of Asheville and has a population of 8,500 people. The median home price in Black Mountain is around \$455,000. This town is famous for music, art, and the famous Sourwood Festival.

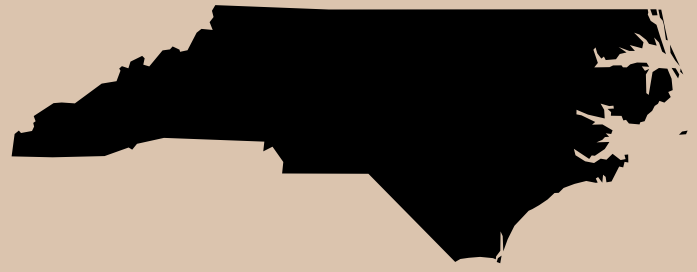

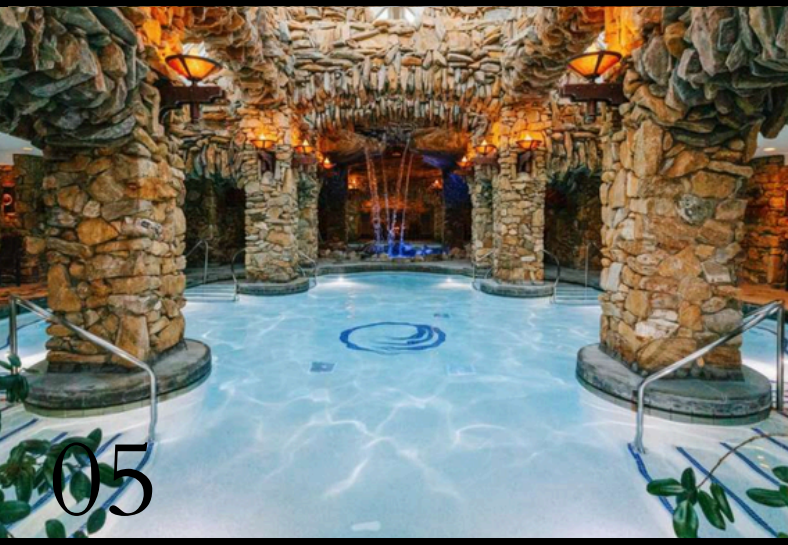

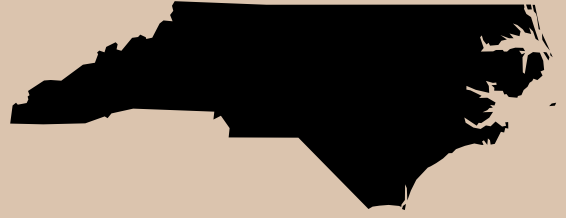
